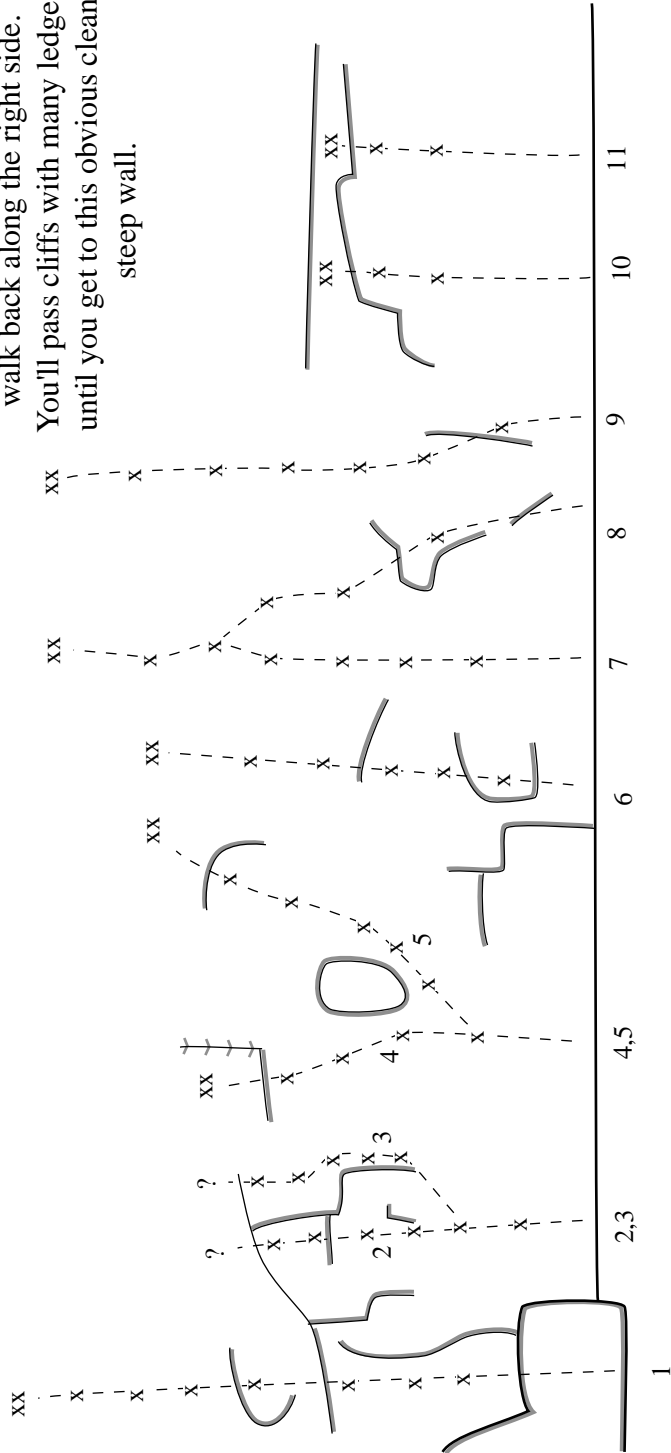


Once at the end of the canyon, walk back along the right side. You'll pass cliffs with many ledges until you get to this obvious clean, steep wall.

Heart Creek, Alberta

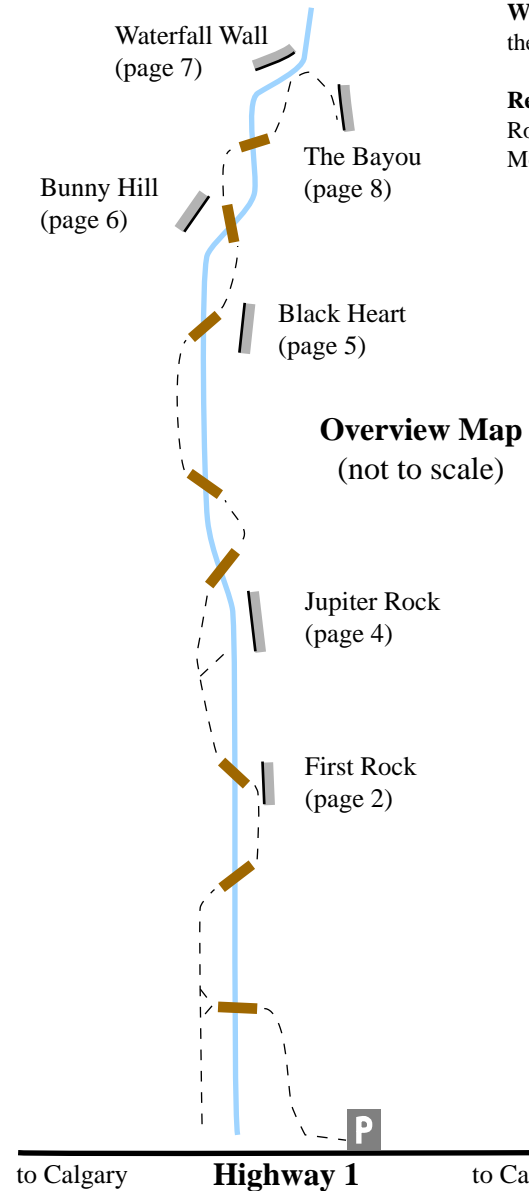
The concentration of climbs in the 5.9 to 5.11 range, close to the road, attracts a lot of climbers. For those seeking difficulty and not afraid of a longer hike, the end of the canyon offers interesting 5.12s.



How to get there: About 15 km east of Canmore. Go toward Calgary on Highway 1. Park just after the Lac des Arcs exit, in the dish between the Calgary 92 km sign, and the reduced lane sign. Walk along the right side of the creek, then cross it on a nice bridge. Follow the overview map underneath and the specific direction to each crag.

When: A summer area. Most of the walls get in the shade in early afternoon.

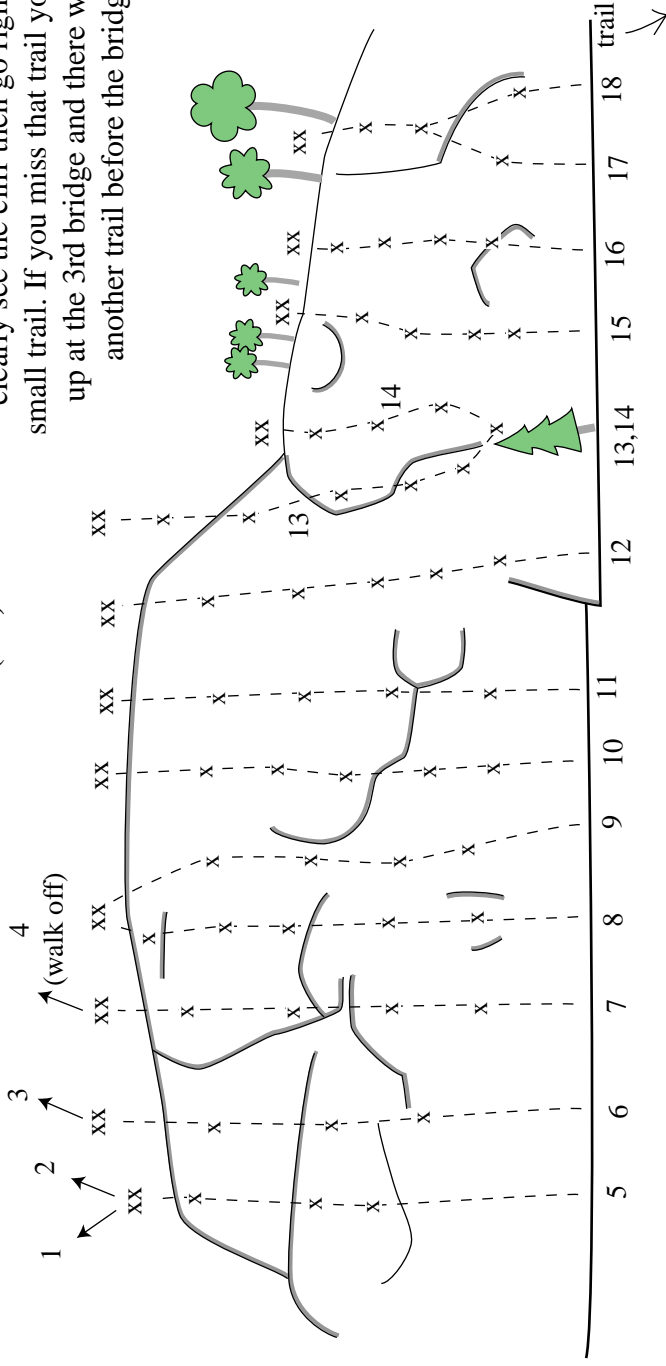

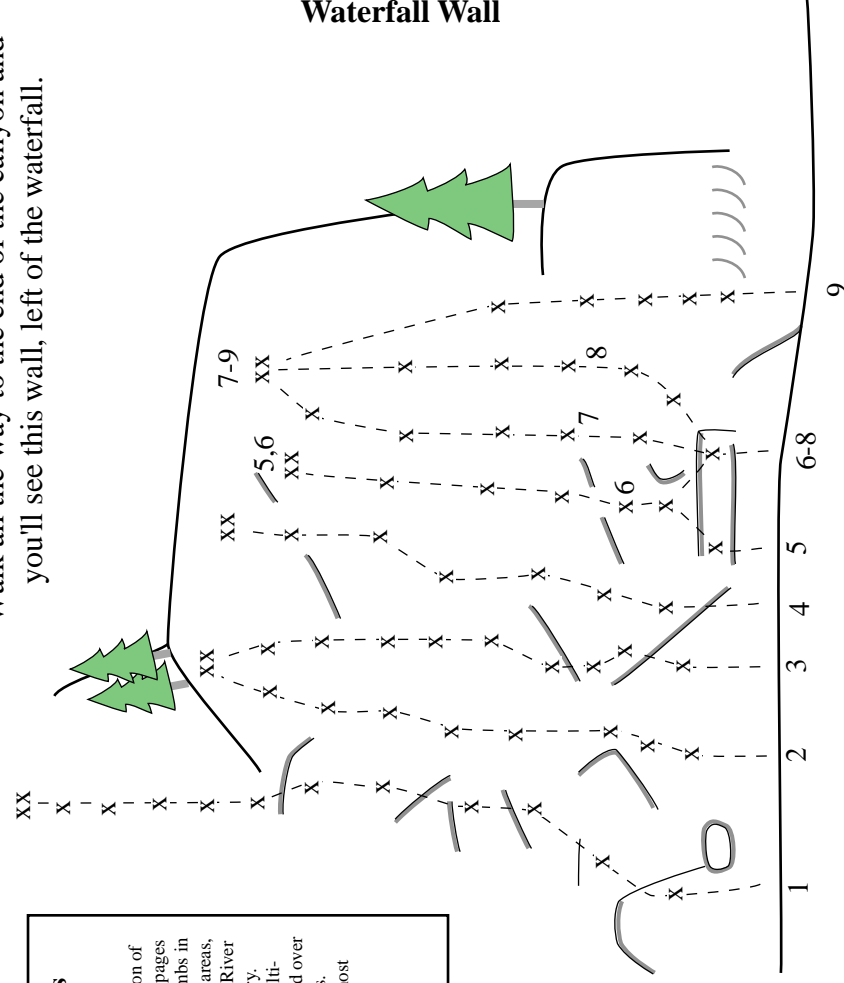

Waterfall Wall

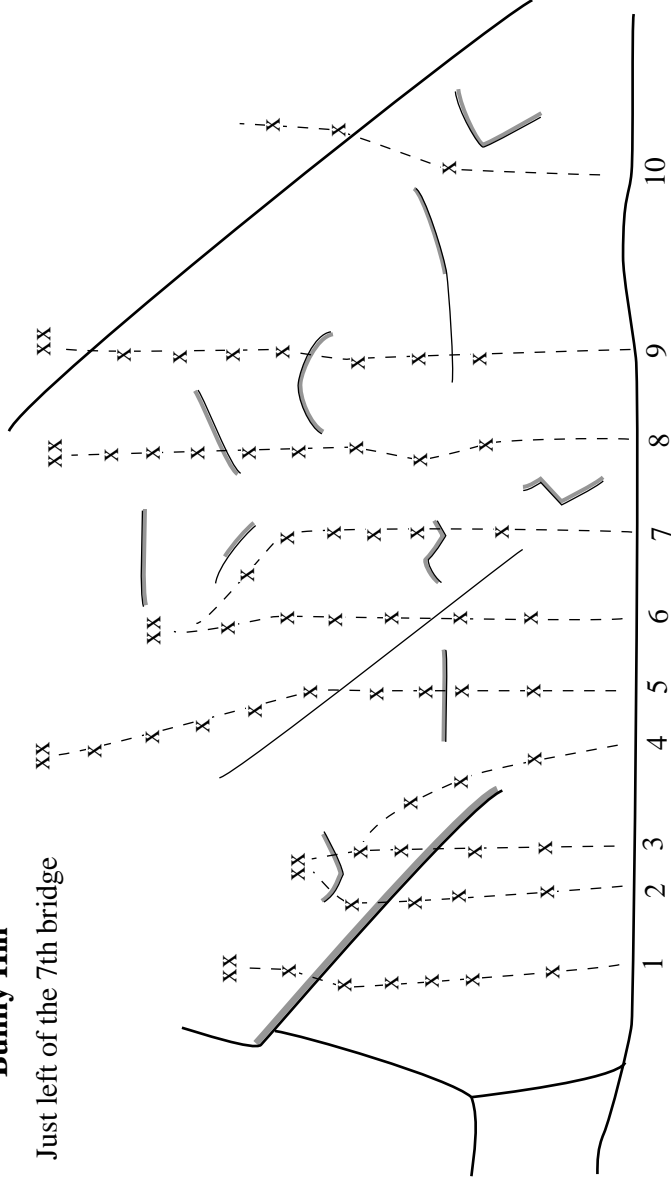
Walk all the way to the end of the canyon and you'll see this wall, left of the waterfall.

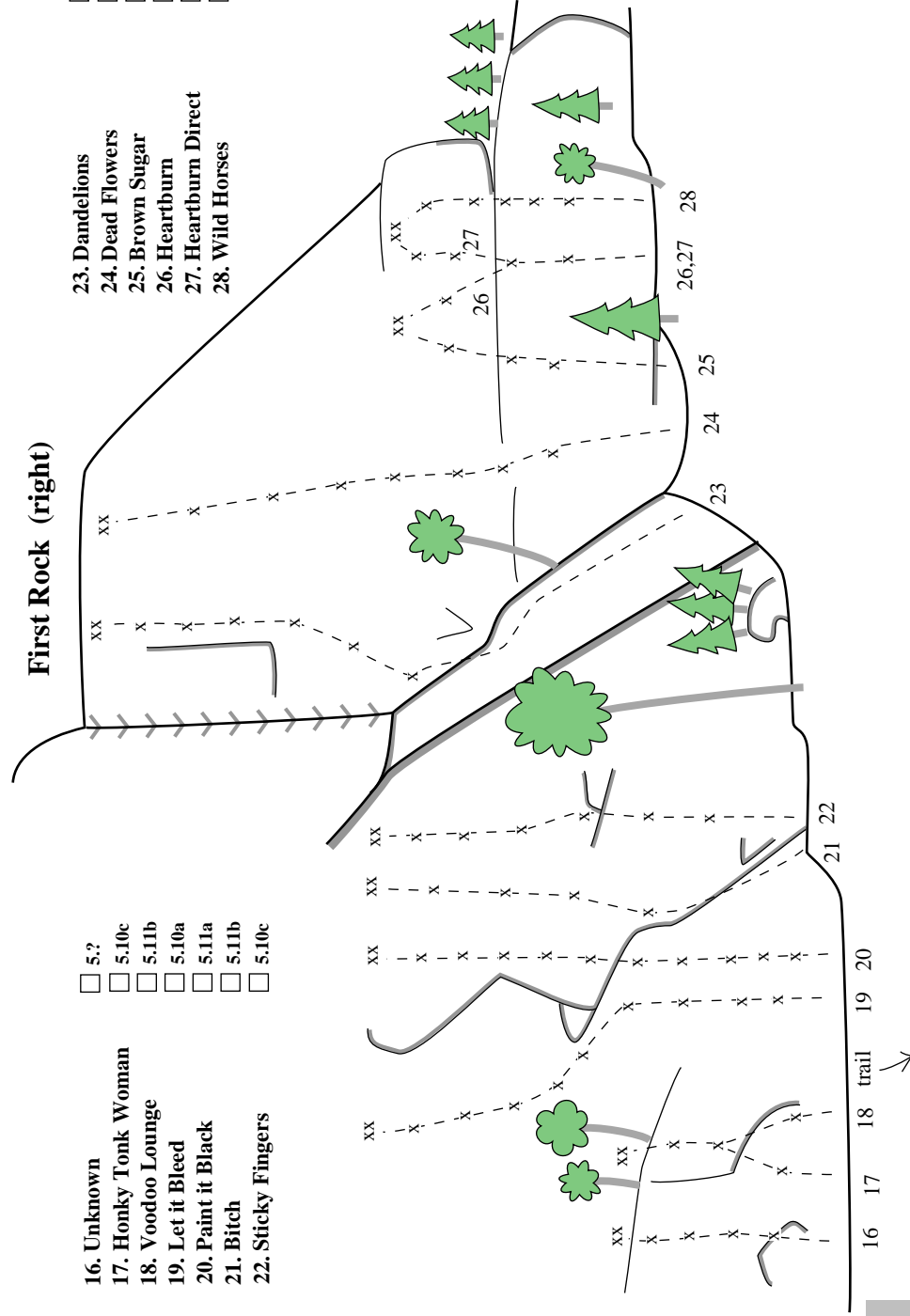

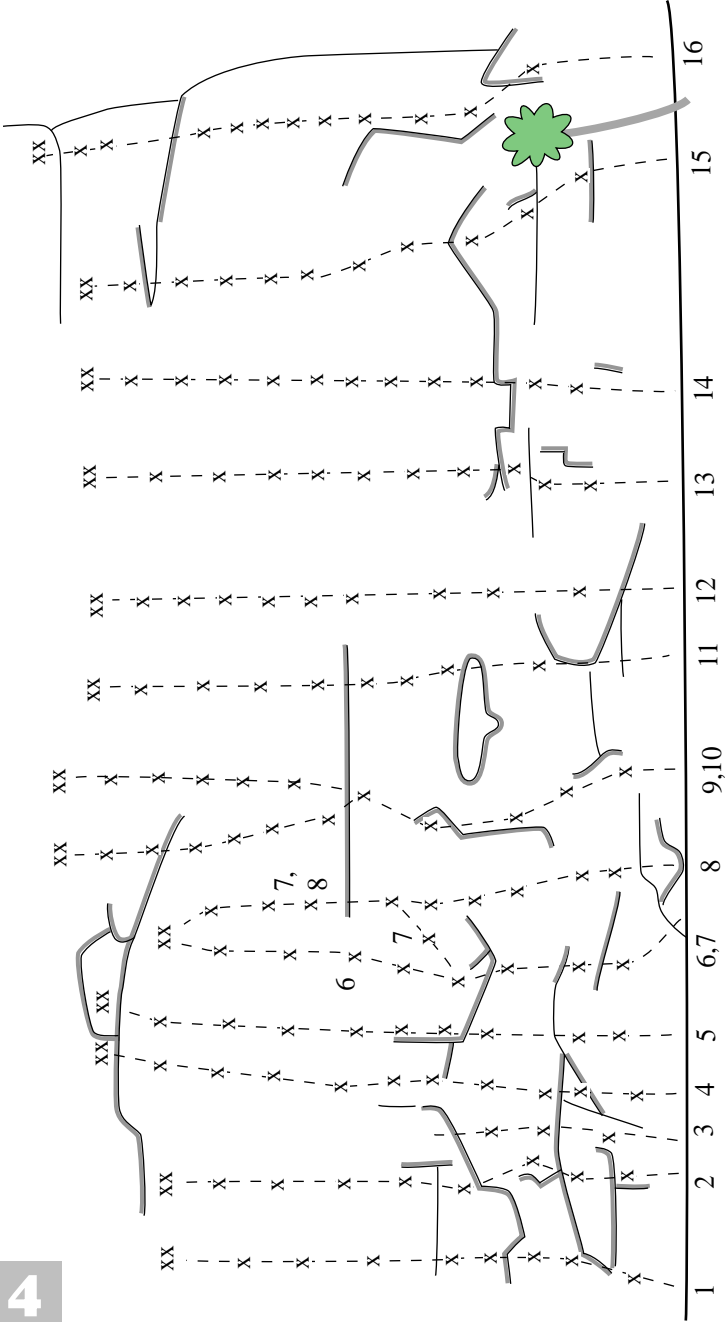

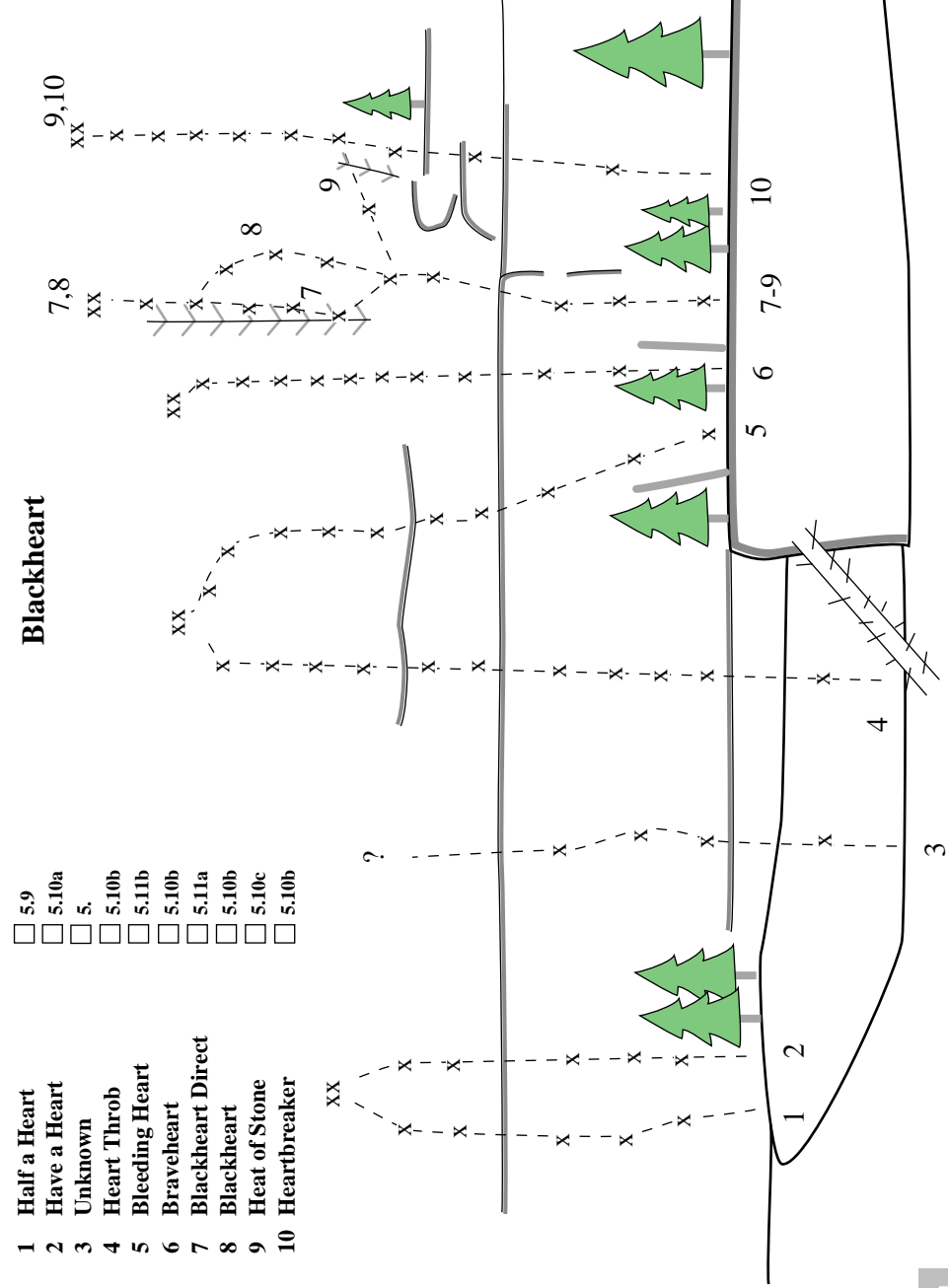
